Self-Regulating Generation Licence

Part 1 – The Licence

1. Grant of Licence

The Bureau hereby grants a self-regulating generation licence (“**Licence**”) to The New Al Ain Hospital (“**Licensee**”) to carry out the activity referred to in Part 1, paragraph 4.

This Licence is granted in exercise of the powers conferred on the Bureau by Article (82) of Law No (2).

2. Conditions of Licence

This Licence is granted subject to the Conditions in Part 2 of this Licence and for the term referred to in Part 1, paragraph 3. This Licence is subject to revocation in accordance with Condition 4.

3. Licence term

This Licence is effective from 6 September 2017

4. Licensed Activity

The activity permitted to be carried out by the Licensee is the generation of electricity up to a maximum installed capacity of 1486.8 kWp (1.5 MW) employing the use of photovoltaic (PV) solar panels mounted on the roof-top of the hospital building, in Al Jimi Area – AL Ain Region – Abu Dhabi. The generation installations shall be connected to the supply side of the customer’s meter.

5. Definitions

Bureau means the Regulation and Supervision Bureau for the Water, Wastewater and Electricity Sector as established under Law No (2);

Electricity Distribution Code means in relation to any distribution company, an electricity distribution code or codes required to be drawn up by a Licensed Electricity Distribution Operator and approved by the Bureau, and as from time to time revised with the approval of the Bureau;

Law No (2) means Law No (2) of 1998 Concerning the Regulation of the Water and Electricity Sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, as amended; and

Licensed Activity means the activity permitted to be carried out by the Licensee pursuant to the terms of this Licence;

Part 2 – Self-Regulating Generation Conditions

Condition 1 – Compliance

1. In carrying out the Licensed Activity, the Licensee shall comply with the terms of this Licence and Law No (2) at all times.

Condition 2 – Provision of information to the Bureau

1. The Licensee shall submit to the Bureau, in such manner and at such times as the Bureau may require, such Information as the Bureau may consider necessary in light of the Conditions or as it may require for the purpose of performing the functions assigned or transferred to it by or under Law No (2).

Condition 3 – Health, Safety and the Environment

1. The Licensee shall comply with all current health and safety and environmental regulations and legislation in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, where applicable.
2. The Licensee shall ensure that at all times the solar PV generation system is only operated, maintained and can only be accessed by appropriately qualified personnel.

Condition 4 – Revocation

1. The Bureau may at any time revoke this Licence by giving at least 30 days prior written notice to the Licensee:
 - a) if the Licensee agrees in writing with the Bureau that this Licence should be revoked;
 - b) if the Licensee breaches any Condition of this Licence or Law No (2);
 - c) if any information provided by the Licensee pursuant to this Licence or in its application for this Licence is found to be false or misleading;
 - d) if the Licensee ceases to carry on the Licensed Activity permitted by this Licence;
 - e) if the Licensee is convicted of having committed an offence under Law No (2) in making its application for this Licence.

Condition 5 – Regulations

1. The Licensee shall comply with all regulations issued by the Bureau pursuant to Law No (2) insofar as applicable.
2. The Licensee shall comply with the Electricity Distribution Code insofar as it is applicable.
