1. Introduction

1.1 APC has applied to the Bureau for a renewal of Consent Number ED/L03/009 (Revision 4) granted to APC for the supply and sale of Demineralised Water to Specified Customers.

2. Definitions

2.1 Terms used in this Consent shall unless defined herein or the context otherwise admits have the same meanings as ascribed to them in Law or the Licence.

ADWEC: means Abu Dhabi Water and Electricity Company

APC: means Arabian Power Company

Bureau: means the Regulation and Supervision Bureau for the Water and Electricity Sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi (as established under the Law)

Consent: means this Consent granted by the Bureau to APC (including any modifications from time to time)

Demineralised Water: means high purity water from multi-stage flash distillation process, with conductivity of 0.25 to 0.45 $\mu\text{s}/\text{cm}$ and pH of 6.4 to 6.6

Law: means Law No (2)

Law No (2): means Law No (2) of 1998 concerning the Regulation of the Water and Electricity Sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, as amended

Licence: means licence number ED/L01/013, Issue 1, Rev (1), granted by the Bureau to APC to carry out Water Desalination and Electricity Generation (including any modifications from time to time)

Licensed Activities: means the activities permitted to be carried out by APC pursuant to the terms of its Licence

PWPA: means the Power and Water Purchase Agreement between ADWEC and APC (including any amendments from time to time).

Specified Customers: means the customers listed in paragraph 4 (f)

Water Quality Regulations: means the Water Quality Regulations (2009) issued by the Bureau pursuant to Article (62) of the Law (including any amendments from time to time)

3. Renewal of Consent

3.1 The Bureau hereby renews Consent Number ED/L03/009 (Revision 4) issued by the Bureau on 22 April 2009 (under Condition 2, Part 2 of the Licence) for the supply and sale by APC of Demineralised Water to Specified Customers for the period as specified in paragraph 5.

4. Conditions of this Consent

4.1 This Consent shall continue to be subject to the following conditions:

- (a) APC will continue to comply with all the requirements of the Law and the Licence in respect of its regulated activities or the Licensed Activities or activities necessarily ancillary thereto.
- (b) APC will meet any health, safety and environment related requirements imposed by the Bureau or any other authority having jurisdiction over APC's activities.
- (c) The activities relating to the production and sale of Demineralised Water should not adversely affect the operations and costs of the regulated activities or the Licensed Activities or activities necessarily ancillary thereto.
- (d) APC will ensure that the activities relating to production and sale of Demineralised Water will not under any circumstances affect the quality parameters of potable water produced by APC for ADWEC according to the Water Quality Regulations prescribed by the Bureau from time to time.
- (e) APC will continue to meet the requirements of the water entry specifications in the Connection and Interface Agreement between APC and the Abu Dhabi Transmission and Despatch Company.


5. Period
