Consent for Provision of Manpower Services

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Abu Dhabi Transmission and Despatch Company (TRANSCO) has applied to the Regulation and Supervision Bureau (the Bureau) on 18 January 2011 for renewal of the Consent given by the Bureau to TRANSCO to provide Manpower Services, which expired on 31 December 2009.

2. Definitions

- 2.1 Terms used in this Consent shall, unless defined herein or the context otherwise admits, have the same meanings as ascribed to them in the Law or the Licence.

Consent means this consent granted by the Bureau to TRANSCO to undertake Manpower Services.

Financial Materiality in relation to this Consent, is deemed to be 0.1 (nought point one) percent of TRANSCO's annual Maximum Allowed Revenues (MARs) in that year for water and electricity combined set under the price control mechanism by the Bureau.

Law means Law No (2) of 1998 concerning the Regulation of the Water and Electricity Sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, as amended.

Licence means the licence granted by the Bureau to TRANSCO, document reference ED/L01/005, to carry out the transmission of electricity and water for the purpose of enabling a supply to be given to any premise, as modified from time to time.

Licensed Activities means those activities which TRANSCO is authorised to carry out under its Licence.

Manpower Services means services other than TRANSCO's Licensed Activities which are provided by TRANSCO to customers connected to its transmission network.

Water Quality Regulations means the Water Quality Regulations, Revision 3, 1 January 2010 issued by the Bureau, as amended from time to time.

3. Renewal of Consent

3.1 The Bureau, having duly considered the application from TRANSCO, renews its Consent to TRANSCO granted under Condition 2 of Part 2 of its Licence, to provide Manpower Services.

4. Conditions to this Consent

4.1 This Consent is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) TRANSCO will continue to comply with all the requirements of the Law and the Licence in respect of its Licensed Activities.
- (b) This Consent must not adversely affect the operations and costs of TRANSCO's Licensed Activities. TRANSCO shall ensure the financial ring fencing between the activities covered by this Consent and its Licensed Activities.
- (c) TRANSCO will meet health, safety and environmental related requirements imposed by the Bureau or any other authority having jurisdiction over TRANSCO's activities.
- (d) TRANSCO will ensure that this Consent will not under any circumstances affect its performance against the quality parameters according to the Water Quality Regulations prescribed by the Bureau from time to time.

- (e) TRANSCO shall provide Manpower Services only to those customers with which it has an appropriate contractual arrangement.
- (f) If income in relation to the activities covered by this Consent in any financial year exceeds Financial Materiality, then TRANSCO will in that year comply with all of the requirements of Condition 8 of the Licence as if the activities covered by this Consent were a Separate Business as defined in the Licence.
- (g) TRANSCO shall levy cost-reflective charges for Manpower Services, such charges being subject to the prior written approval of the Bureau.

5. Duration of Consent

- 5.1 This Consent, as renewed, shall remain valid up to 31 December 2014.
- 5.2 Not less than 30 days prior to the expiry of this Consent as specified in paragraph 5.1, TRANSCO must write to the Bureau to either:
 - (a) request an extension of the Consent; or
 - (b) confirm that the activities to which this Consent applies are no longer being carried out by TRANSCO.

6. Modification and Revocation

- 6.1 This Consent is subject to modification or revocation by the Bureau at any time with prior written notice to TRANSCO.
